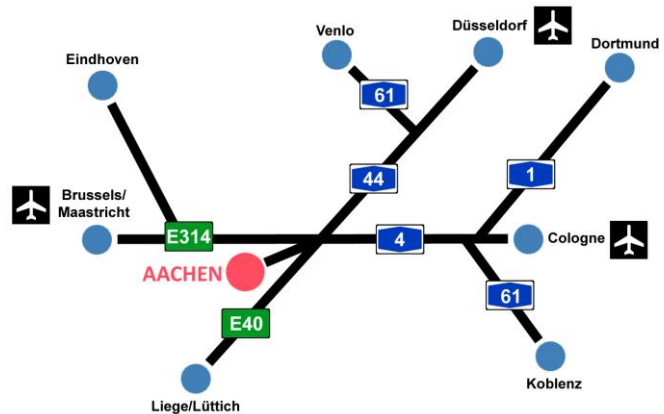


## How to reach the Institute for Environmental Research (RWTH Aachen University):

**By car:** Coming from Liege, Düsseldorf, Cologne, or the Netherlands take the Autobahn A4 and exit at "Aachen-Laurensberg". Turn right to get on the main street to Aachen. After ca. 1 km keep left at exit "Uniklinik/Vaals/RWTH-Melaten". After ca. 2 km leave at the exit "Uniklinik/RWTH Melaten". At the roundabout take the first exit (RWTH Melaten) and park your car in the car park after ca. 400 m on the right side of the street. After leaving the car park via the main entrance of the car park, cross the street, keep diagonally left and go into the "Wendingweg". After a short walk, you will reach a 3-floor grey-red



building called "**Sammelbau Biologie**". In the main entrance hall go left to the octagonal stairwell. The Institute for Environmental Research is located in wing C (ground floor, floors 2 and 3; the secretariat is in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, room 42C253).

**By train:** Coming from the north via Düsseldorf leave the train at "Aachen West" station and take the bus 3A, 33 or 73 (direction "Uniklinik" and/or "Vaals") and get off at the bus stop "Wendingweg". Coming from the West via Cologne leave the train at "Aachen Hbf" (main station) and take the bus 3B to "Uniklinik". Bus driving from both train stations to the venue takes about 10-15 min (bus schedule: [www.aseag.de](http://www.aseag.de)).
